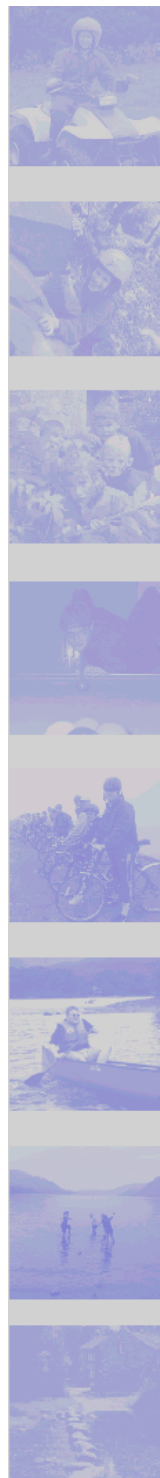
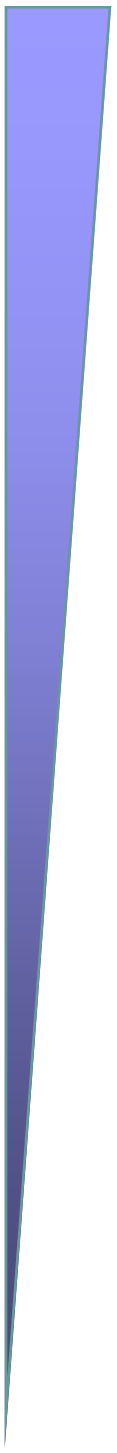

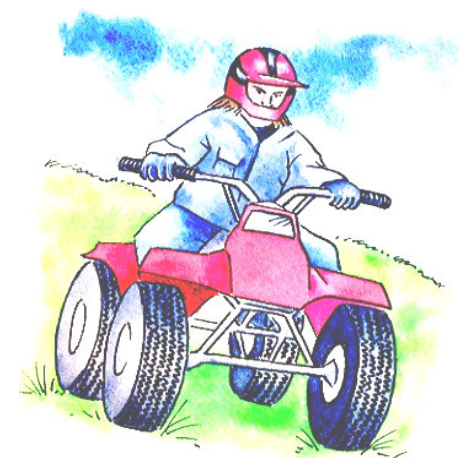

QuadSquad Road Safety & Training Programme

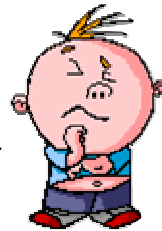
Stand alone sessions:

1. Road Safety - 2 hours

The main causes of accidents and how to avoid them
Issues for young road users
Negatives of driving

2. Theory Test Practice - 2 hours

Using latest DSA approved software.
Learn about the theory test
Practice and complete a full mock test



QuadSquad Programme:

1. Road Safety - 2 hours

As stand alone session

2. Level One - Quad Training (introduction) - 1 hour

Kit, control and basic operations

3. Level Two - Quad Training (basic) - 2 hours

(Max group 8 people)

Basic handling, corners, slopes, tracks, ride several miles around our beautiful venue.

Level **one** to **three** can be completed in one day (midweek) or one evening and a Saturday morning. In summer it can also be over two evenings depending on availability.

Up to Level **two** quad training must be completed before proceeding

4 **Extra Riding Session:-3 hours** (max group 8 people)
Extra practice if required for mastering the techniques in level one and two

5 **Quad training:** to ATV Operator (leisure) standards
5-6 hours, (max group 4 people)
Health & Safety, maintenance, route planning, handling all types of territory, solo ride to pass.

6 **Night Riding:** Winter only -2/3 hours
(max group 8 people)
Sections 1,2,3 and 5 must have already been completed before learning how to conquer the massive differences in riding at night at our pitch black venue in the hills!

Groups from inside the Lancashire County Council area will qualify for up to three AQA's in ATV operations.

AQA's are an accredited national awards scheme

Conditions of Booking

Bookings are accepted on condition that the young people belong to the organisation making the booking, and are prepared to enter into a **contract of involvement** with LACYP, which also entails producing a letter of thanks to the landowners on the successful completion of the programme.
